Planting Instructions

While you're preparing the hole, let the roots soak in a container of warm water.

- 1. Choose a sunny location with well drained soil.
- 2. Dig a hole wide enough to easily spread the roots and at least 20 cm (8" deep).
- 3. Amend soil if necessary by mixing a 1 part peat moss, 1 part compost to 3 parts earth.
- 4. Water the soil mixture.

You're now ready to plant.

- 5. Fill the half of the hole with the prepared soil mixture.
- 6. Place the bush at the same soil level as planted in the pot.
- 7. Fill in the hole and thoroughly water.

After Care

- 8. Continue to water throughout the summer season.
- 9. Do not fertilize at planting but 2 weeks later.

10. Sawdust mulch to a depth of 5-8 cm is often beneficial to blueberries.

Live Plants - water immediately and place in a frost-free area until planting!
