Planting Instructions

While you're preparing the hole, let the roots soak in a container of warm water.

- 1. Choose a location that receives full sun.
- 2. Dig a hole wide enough to easily spread the roots and at least 30 cm (12" deep).
- 3. Amend soil if necessary by mixing a 1 part peat moss, 1 part compost to 3 parts earth.
- 4. Water the soil mixture.

You're now ready to plant.

- 5. Fill the half of the hole with the prepared soil mixture.
- 6. Place the bush at the same soil level as planted in the pot
- 7. Fill in the hole and thoroughly water.

After Care

- 8. Continue to water and remove any faded blooms, to encourage next years buds.
- 9. In a few years you can prune your lilac just after blooming has finished. Lilac shoots can take up to 3 years to produce a bloom.

Store in a Cool, Dry Place Until Planting!
