

Berry Blend Raspberry Collection

Before planting rehydrate canes by trimming 2" off the tops of the cane and 2" off the roots of the plant. Then fully submerge the canes and roots in luke warm water for 24 hours. Only plant outdoors once all chance of frost has passed - or plant in containers indoors.

Planting Instructions

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1. Choose a sunny location with well drained soil.
2. Dig a hole wide enough to easily spread the roots and at least 20 cm (8" deep).
3. Amend soil if necessary by mixing a 1 part peat moss, 1 part compost to 3 parts earth.
4. Water the soil mixture.

You're now ready to plant.

5. Fill the half of the hole with the prepared soil mixture.
6. Place the canes 8 cm (3") deep and space 90 cm (36") apart in the row.
7. Fill in the hole with soil and thoroughly water.
8. Prune the freshly planed cane to 2" above the soil level. This will encourage the roots to send up new growth.

After Care

9. Continue to water throughout the summer season.
 10. Feed by mulching well rotted manure..
 11. **Everbearing pruning** - for a summer crop, cut back canes partly after fall fruiting.
- Summer Bearing** - prune out canes that produced fruit in the fall.
