Planting Instructions

While you're preparing the hole, let the roots soak in a container of warm water.

1. Choose a sunny location with well drained soil.
2. Dig a hole wide enough to easily spread the roots and at least 20 cm (8" deep).
3. Amend soil if necessary by mixing a 1 part peat moss, 1 part compost to 3 parts earth.
4. Water the soil mixture.

You're now ready to plant.

5. Fill the half of the hole with the prepared soil mixture.
6. Place the bush at the same soil level as planted in the pot.
7. Fill in the hole and thoroughly water.

After Care

8. Continue to water throughout the summer season.
9. Do not fertilize at planting but 2 weeks later.
10. Sawdust mulch to a depth of 5-8 cm is often beneficial to blueberries.
