### **Planting Instructions**

## While you're preparing the hole, let the roots soak in a container of warm water.

- 1. Choose a location that receives full to part shade.
- 2. Dig a hole wide enough to easily spread the roots and at least 20 cm (8" deep).
- 3. Amend soil if necessary by mixing a 1 part peat moss, 1 part compost to 3 parts earth.
- 4. Water the soil mixture.

### You're now ready to plant.

- 5. Fill the half of the hole with the prepared soil mixture.
- 6. Place the roots and/ or bulbs at the depth noted on the label of the package
- 7. Fill in the hole and thoroughly water.

#### After Care

- 8. Continue to water throughout the summer season.
- 9. In the fall or early spring remove the faded leaves and debris from last years growth.
