

# Effortless Perennial Gardens



- A. Crocosmia 'Lucifer' (montbretia) Zone 5
- B. Astiatic x Longiflorum Lily 'Pavia' Zone 4
- C. Liatris purple (blazing star) Zone 2
- D. Hosta 'Francee' (Plantain Lily) Zone 2
- E. Hemerocallis Red (daylily) Zone 2
- F. Sedum spectabile (stonecrop) Zone 3
- G. Hemerocallis Frans Hals (Daylily) Zone 2
- H. Bergenia cordifolia Zone 2
- I. Liatris White (blazing star) Zone 2
- J. Dicentra spectabilis (bleeding heart) Zone 2

## Planting Instructions

**While you're preparing the hole, let the roots soak in a container of warm water.**

1. Choose a location that receives full to part sun.
2. Dig a hole wide enough to easily spread the roots and at least 20 cm (8" deep).
3. Amend soil if necessary by mixing a 1 part peat moss, 1 part compost to 3 parts earth.
4. Water the soil mixture.

**You're now ready to plant.**

5. Fill the half of the hole with the prepared soil mixture.
6. Place the roots and/ or bulbs at the depth noted on the label of the package
7. Fill in the hole and thoroughly water.

**After Care**

8. Continue to water and disbud any faded blooms throughout the summer season.
9. In the fall or early spring remove the faded leaves and debris from last years growth.

**Store in a cool dry place for up to 2 weeks after receiving. Plant outdoors once evening temperatures stay above 6-8 C or start in containers indoors.**
