- B. *Iris sibirica* 'Butter & Sugar'
- C. *Iris sibirica* 'Miss Apple'



Planting Instructions

While you're preparing the hole, let the roots soak in a container of warm water.

1. Choose a location that receives full to part sun.
2. Dig a hole wide enough to easily spread the roots and at least 20 cm (8" deep).
3. Amend soil if necessary by mixing in 1 part peat moss, 1 part compost to 3 parts earth.
4. Water the soil mixture.

You're now ready to plant.

5. Fill the 2/3 of the hole with the prepared soil mixture.
6. Place the crown of the plant (where the roots meet the shoots) at the soil level.
7. Fill in the hole with soil and thoroughly water.

After Care

8. Continue to water and disbud any faded blooms throughout the summer season.
9. In the fall or early spring remove the faded leaves and debris from last years growth.
