Planting Instructions

While you're preparing the hole, let the roots soak in a container of warm water.

Everbearing Planting Instructions:

Separate the plants and plant each with the crown even with the ground level. Plant in late March-April in beds consisting of 2-3 rows that are 30 cm (12") apart. Space each plant within a row about 50 cm (20") apart. There should be a 60 cm (24") wide path between each bed of 2-3 rows. In containers, plant 5 plants in a 30cm (12") pot. Remove any runners to maintain the plants as large, single plants. Remove all blossoms for 6 weeks after initial planting. Then allow flowers to develop into fruit.

June Bearing Planting Instructions:

Separate the plants and plant each with the crown even with the ground level. Space the plants about 50 cm (20") apart in rows 90 cm (36") apart and water well after planting. Runners will develop and root freely, eventually forming a matted row of plants about 60 cm (24") wide. During the first growth year remove all blossoms and fruit stems until the following June and then let the plants bear fruit.

Store in a cool dry place for up to 2 weeks after receiving. Plant outdoors once evening temperatures stay above 6-8 C or start in containers indoors.
